- Owners are responsible for the behaviour and welfare of their dog at all times.
- SCOLA and LBS accept no responsibility for the welfare or behaviour of dogs at the show.
- Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- Owners must clean up after their dogs
- Water will be provided but please think about what else your dog might need for the day
- Please respect the wishes of other dog owners and event attendees
- Do not bring any dogs to the show that are unwell, in season or aggressive
