


Fees for 2015/16

You may be aware of the significant challenges facing Adult Learning providers as more funding is prioritised towards the national targets.

The funding for courses leading to certificates is focused on very specific priorities leaving less money available for other courses.

Sutton College (SCOLA) has, like other providers, experienced year on cuts to funding and is managing its finances in a variety of ways including economising on staffing and resources. We do not receive

The fees are constantly monitored and we have taken the approach of selective fee increases rather than a blanket % increase. Some fees have increased while others have remained the same.
