Who or What is VERA?



The Sutton College virtual learning environment is called VERA – standing for 'Virtual Education Resources & Activities'. It can give you access to a range of resources such as a Sutton College 'yourname@learn.scola.ac.uk' email address which your tutor will issue. This email provides a safe and secure method to communicate with your tutor and other students on your course.

You can also access course sites that your tutor may create and share with you to support your studies. This can help to extend your learning outside the classroom, act as a reminder or revision tool, or help you to keep up if you miss any of your classes. Your student VERA access also provides you with a Google account.

VERA can be accessed from the home page of the Sutton College website with your Sutton College email address and password. The resources are available to you during your time as a student in the college.
