### How do we face the challenges ahead?

Please have your say!

Whatever the Chancellor's Autumn Statement says we are fully aware that further cuts to public funding are inevitable. We have managed to cope with a 22% reduction this academic year but we are planning our strategy for next year now. We need your views to inform our

plans. The choices are stark and will impact on learners and staff. We want to prioritise services being available for the future but more changes are needed to secure that aim.

The College has reduced staffing levels particularly across the management team and all contracts for facilities and maintenance have been re-negotiated to save money. Working practices have been reviewed and processes made more efficient. These measures have been successful in reducing expenditure.

One strategy is to increase student fees to compensate for less public funding. That will not be a popular option but all providers are having to raise fees to maintain a programme of courses. An option is to reduce the number of courses and only offer a limited range of subjects. Other possibilities include reducing the course hours or number of sessions or even offering more opportunities for learning without a teacher being present at all times.
