GO MEAT FREE: Try one day a week. Meat production is one of the biggest contributors to climate change and the pollution of landscapes and waterways.



SAVE ENERGY:

Reduce carbon emissions and turn off appliances and lights and wash clothes at lower temperatures.



SWAP DON'T SHOP:

Donate or swap unwanted clothes items at charity shops or at locally organised swap events



REPAIR NOT REPLACE:

If it's broken, try to fix it. Upcycle clothes and restore and repurpose furniture - learn with us or online.



WALK MORE:

Good for your health and good for the environment. A five minute car journey to the shops is an easy swap.
